MARCHING PRIDE

As we end the school year much of our attention and time is being focused on preparation for our band activities for next school year. Of all these activities, one of the earliest (and most fun) is our marching band camp. We are looking forward to a wonderful marching band season!

Even though we have already given you the dates for band camp and our pre-camp activities, this memo will give you the cost and payment dates and other important information. WIND PLAYER NEW MEMBER CAMP

A student who plays a wind instrument (Brass and Woodwinds) and is a first year member of the CHS Marching Band (including students who marched their 8th grade year) is **required** to attend the **New Member Camp**. The dates for the camp are **July 13-17 from 1:00 PM to 4:00 PM at Central H.S.** We will spend the majority of this time on marching fundamentals so that everything we learn at band camp is not brand new.

PERCUSSION CAMP*

Any student who is a member of the percussion section (battery and front ensemble) is **required** to attend the week of **Percussion Camp**. The dates for the camp are **July 13-17, from 9:00 AM to 12:00 Noon and 1:00 PM to 5:00 PM** and will be held at Central H.S. **(Please note the full wind/percussion music rehearsals on July 13, 14, 16) This camp is mandatory for all percussion members.**

COLOR GUARD CAMP

All members of the Color Guard are required to attend the week of Visual Ensemble Camp. The work for our show will begin to be put on during this week, so this week is as important for guard members as band camp. The dates are **July 13-17, from 9:00 AM to 12:00 Noon and 1:00 PM to 5:00 PM** and will be held at Central H.S. **This camp is mandatory for all Visual Ensemble Members.**

SUMMER MUSIC REHEARSALS*

All members of the marching band wind and percussion sections are required to attend the three rehearsals held prior to band camp. These rehearsals are as follows:

SUMMER AND FALL REHEARSALS

Unless you had a previously excused absence, you are expected to attend all pre-camp rehearsals held during the summer months. **CHECK THE CALENDAR.** The more work you do during the summer, the less you have to do later. Please check the calendar for specific dates and times. **All rehearsals during full camp are required for ALL STUDENTS.**

General Information:

1. No student will be allowed to leave campus once at band camp except in the case of an emergency and with the permission of the band director.
2. Friends, Alumni, etc. are asked not to visit during the camp until the performance on Saturday unless there is an emergency.
3. All Camp and Band Rules are in addition to any rules set forth by the Carroll County School Board and Central High School.
4. Examine the entire schedule and pay special attention to reporting times.
5. A daily practice routine should begin now. Music is the reason why we do this. Please come prepared to rehearse music. We will spend a great deal of time this year rehearsing music.
6. Please be ready for the heat when you arrive to camp. Band camp is not the place to start a diet. The temperatures are extremely hot and humid. A lot of our rehearsals take place outside so drink plenty of water, bring sunscreen, and rest during the breaks given to you. One last thing..."NO SWEAT...NO PRIDE"
7. Time is precious so please be on time for all rehearsals. There is a lot to be done in a little amount of time. **Early is on time.**
8. Wear comfortable tennis shoes and socks at all times!!!
9. Wear sun screen and a hat at all times when outside. Students are expected to have his/her own water bottle during band camp for the shorter breaks given during the day.

Students are **not** permitted to leave campus during lunch. If you do not wish to eat the lunch provided by the booster club, you will need to bring your own lunch that day or a parent may drop off your lunch at 12:00 p.m. (after the morning rehearsal block)

As a reminder, students **will** be permitted to leave campus during the **dinner break**, however students may not ride with other students, unless in the rare case that it has been pre-approved by Mr. Ruby and the parent of both students has contacted Mr. Ruby in writing for approval. Students may be picked up by his/her parent or you may drive if you have driven to camp that morning. Students will also be permitted to walk to Arby's, Steak and Shake or Chick-Fil-A but nowhere else. The band room will be open during the dinner break but we are not providing meals during this time. Again, students are **not** permitted to transport other students at any time during camp breaks. This has been a rule of the Central band for many years and will be **strictly enforced**.

Drop off and pick up will take place in the ticket booth parking lot. When picking up students after rehearsals/performances, please pull to the very end of the lot so all cars can get on campus without causing a traffic jam on Central Road/Hwy 27.
