***All concert and symphonic band students are required to perform at Graduation and will receive a grade.**

Please make sure you are present and ready to help make this ceremony very special for our band seniors!

*Students should dress nice for the event. No blue jeans, t-shirts, shorts, or hats.

*Band Students will enter the Coliseum from the lower level, right side (as you face building), at the bottom of the hill. Our band trailer will be parked by the door students will enter.

*Music, stands, percussion and tubas will be brought over on the band trailer. All other instruments are the responsibility of the student.

*Traffic will be a concern on Saturday. Please plan accordingly. Students and parents should park in one of the two lots between Z6 and the coliseum. **Do not park by the loading dock doors.**

*Everyone attending graduation that is not a performing band student will have to present a ticket to attend graduation. Only band students and faculty of Central HS will be allowed to enter through the lower level doors to the Coliseum. All other spectators **must** enter through the main gates with a ticket.

*Students who have a brother or sister graduating may sit with family members **AFTER** we play Pomp and Circumstance and the National Anthem.
