The range and depth of musical talent within Central-Carroll High School has produced one of the country's finest band programs. Our student musicians have shown the talent and commitment to earn and maintain an outstanding reputation as they "Strive for Excellence" in each performance.

The Central-Carroll Band Program has a long tradition of excellence. The Central-Carroll Bands have earned superior ratings at every Georgia Music Educator's event for 20 consecutive years. Numerous students from Central – Carroll H.S. are selected each year to the GMEA District Seven Honor Band and GMEA All-State Band. The Central band program is also proud to have had representatives selected to perform in the Brevard Music Camp, Julliard Music Camp, Atlanta Youth Symphony, Metropolitan Atlanta Youth Wind Ensemble, Emory Youth Symphony Orchestra, and the Georgia Governor's Honor's Program.

The Central-Carroll Marching Pride is one of the most recognized band programs in the United States, earning over 500 superior ratings, 200 class placement awards, and 42 Grand Championships in the past 20 years. The Central – Carroll High School Bands have received letters of commendations from both Governor Sonny Purdue and Governor Roy Barnes and two resolutions from the Georgia State House of Legislature. The Central Bands have been presented with the prestigious Certificate of Merit for Marching Excellence from the National Band Association on three occasions.

The Central-Carroll Indoor Winter Guard has garnered several honors over recent years including a medallist for 5 year consecutive years at circuit championships and named as a Winter Guard International National Semi-Finalist for three consecutive years.

The Central Bands have performed for millions of people all over the world. Most recently, the Central-Carroll Marching Pride represented the State of Georgia as the Honor Band of the 2015 Waikiki Holiday Parade and Pearl Harbor Commemoration in Hawaii. The Marching Pride has performed on two occasions in the Tournament of Roses Parade in Pasadena, California. The band has also traveled and performed in Hollywood, California; New York, New York; New Orleans, Louisiana; Philadelphia, Pennsylvania; Nassau, Bahamas; San Francisco, California; Orlando, Florida; London, England; and Brisbane, Australia. In March, the band will perform at the Chicago St. Patrick's Day Parade!

Students in the Central-Carroll band program have the opportunity to participate in a variety of performing ensembles and classes, including two concert bands, jazz ensemble, marching band, two competitive indoor winter guards, percussion ensembles, music theory, visual ensemble class, and numerous small instrumental ensembles.
